STUDY DESIGN



Survey of Non-Medical Use of Prescription Drugs (NMURx) Program



Survey is a tool that provides accurate and timely estimates prescription drug non-medical use (including abuse & misuse) and associated motivations and behaviors among the general population

Study Design



- Semi-annual
- Cross-sectional
- Online
- Self-administered
- Anonymous



NMURx Program



Recruitment

- Online survey panels
 - Volunteer survey-takers
 - Recruited through email, e-newsletter campaigns, traditional banner placements, and social media
- Response rate: 20%



Sampling Methods

- N= 15,000 / launch (30,000 annually)
- Quota sampling based on sex and region
- Random selection from panels



Non-Probability Survey **Base Population** Calibration Weighting Quota Sample

Key Measures

- Definition of Non-Medical Use
 - Use in a way not directed by your healthcare provider, even if just once or just a little. Examples include:
 - You used it without a prescription or with someone else's prescription
 - You used it in greater amounts, more often, or for longer than directed
 - You used it for the experience or feeling it caused
 - You changed it before use by crushing, chewing, dissolving, or heating it



Misuse Reasons



- to reduce pain
- to treat a medical condition or symptom, other than pain
- to relax, reduce stress, or sleep
- to prevent or treat withdrawal symptoms



Abuse Reasons

- for enjoyment
- to get high
- to come down from a high from another drug





Self Harm Reasons

- to hurt yourself
- to end your life






Prescription Opioids Included

NMURx Program: Measures








Prevalence of Non-Medical Use Among Survey Participants






Regional Estimate for Non-Medical Use

Final Summary

- Recent data shows the prevalence of nonmedical use of prescription opioids is ~6.5%
- There is some variation between regions
- Most non-medical use reported is misuse
- Continue monitoring to establish trends over time
